Synthetic

- many inflections
- free word order

Analytical

- fixed word order
- little inflections

Inflectional

- hard to segment
- information in one morphem > 1


Agglutinative:

- easy to segment
- form <-> meaning

Isolating:

- one word = one morphem
- no inflections




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

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Word Formation


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Affixation

noun → adjective (boy + ish)
verb → noun (clear + ance)
adjective → adverb (exact + ly)
noun → verb (moral + ize)
adjective → noun (abstract + ion)
verb → adjective (read + able)
noun → noun (friend + ship)
verb → verb (re + cover)
adjective → adjective (in + flammable)

Compounding


	Adjective	Noun	Verb



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



Sentence Structure


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Phrase Structure Trees

NP - noun phrase

AP - adjective phrase

PP - prepositional phrase

SV - verb phrase

CP - complement phrase

iP - immediately dominated phrase

INFL - inflection

Det - determiner

Aux - auxiliary verb

Comp - complementizer
