## Language Types

### Synthetic

- many inflections
- free word order

### Inflectional

- hard to segment
- information in one morphem > 1

### Agglutinative:

- easy to segment
- form <-> meaning

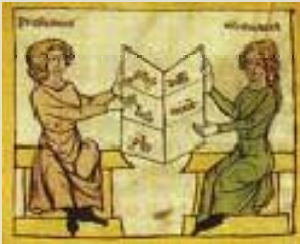
### Analytical

- fixed word order
- little inflections

### Isolating:

- one word = one morphem
- no inflections

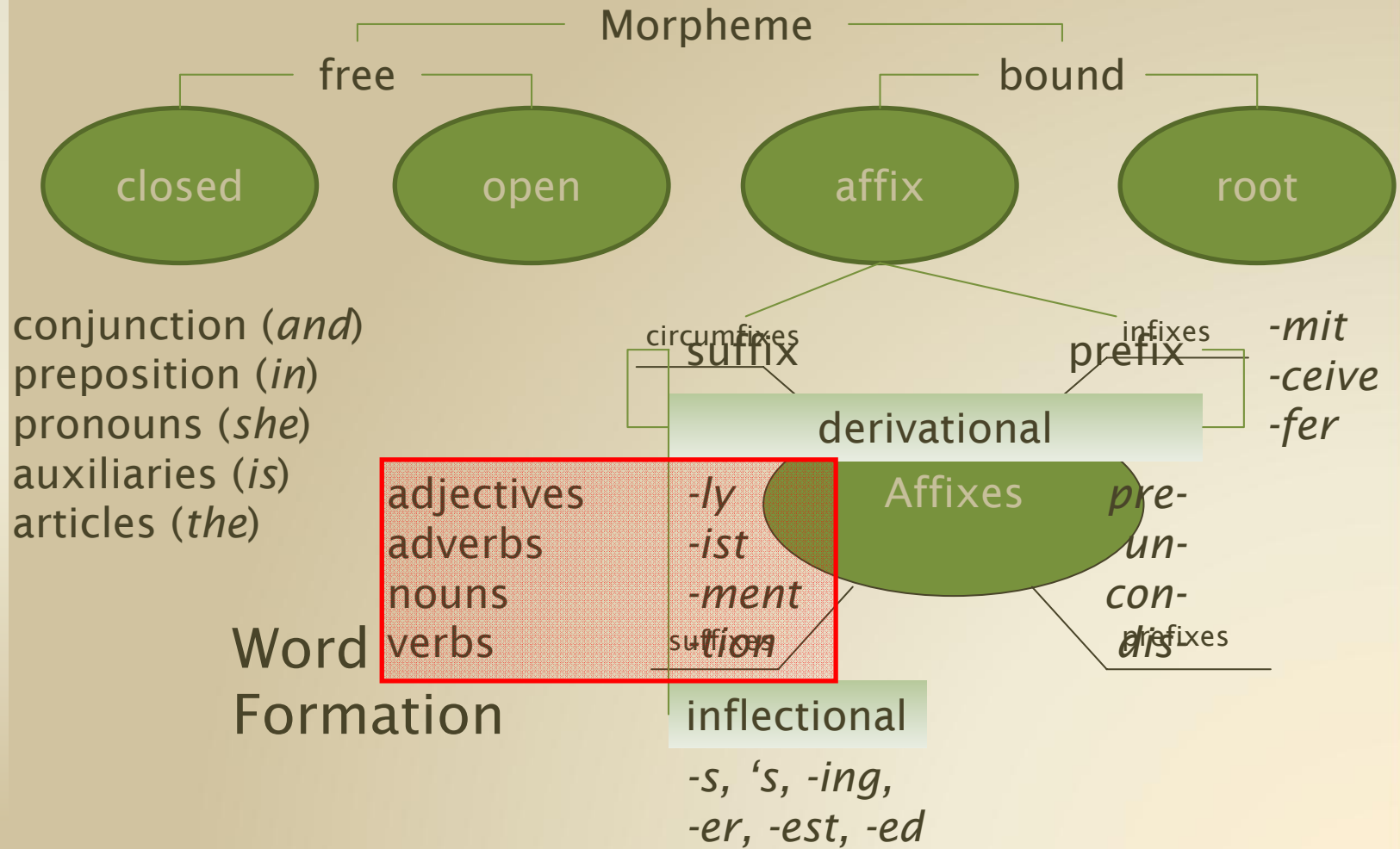

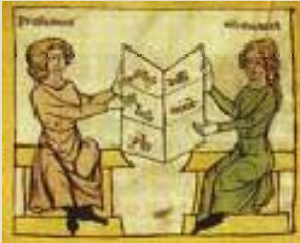
<b>root</b>	system	noun

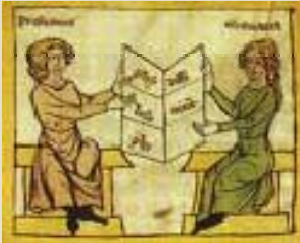
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## Affixation

- verb → noun (clear + ance)
- adjective → adverb (exact + ly)
- noun → verb (moral + ize)
- adjective → noun (abstract + ion)
- verb → adjective (read + able)
- noun → noun (friend + ship)
- verb → verb (re + cover)
- adjective → adjective (in + flammable)

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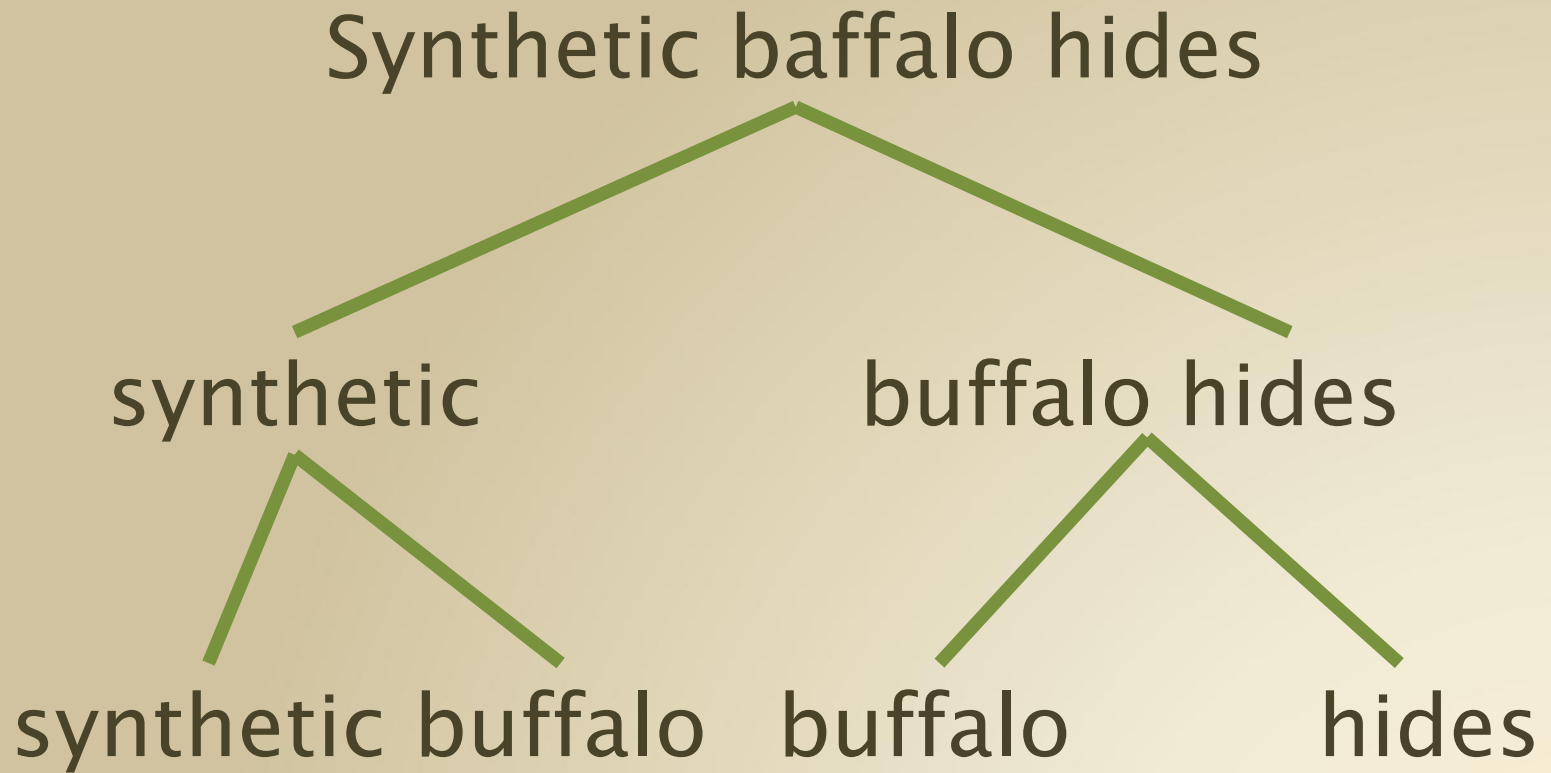

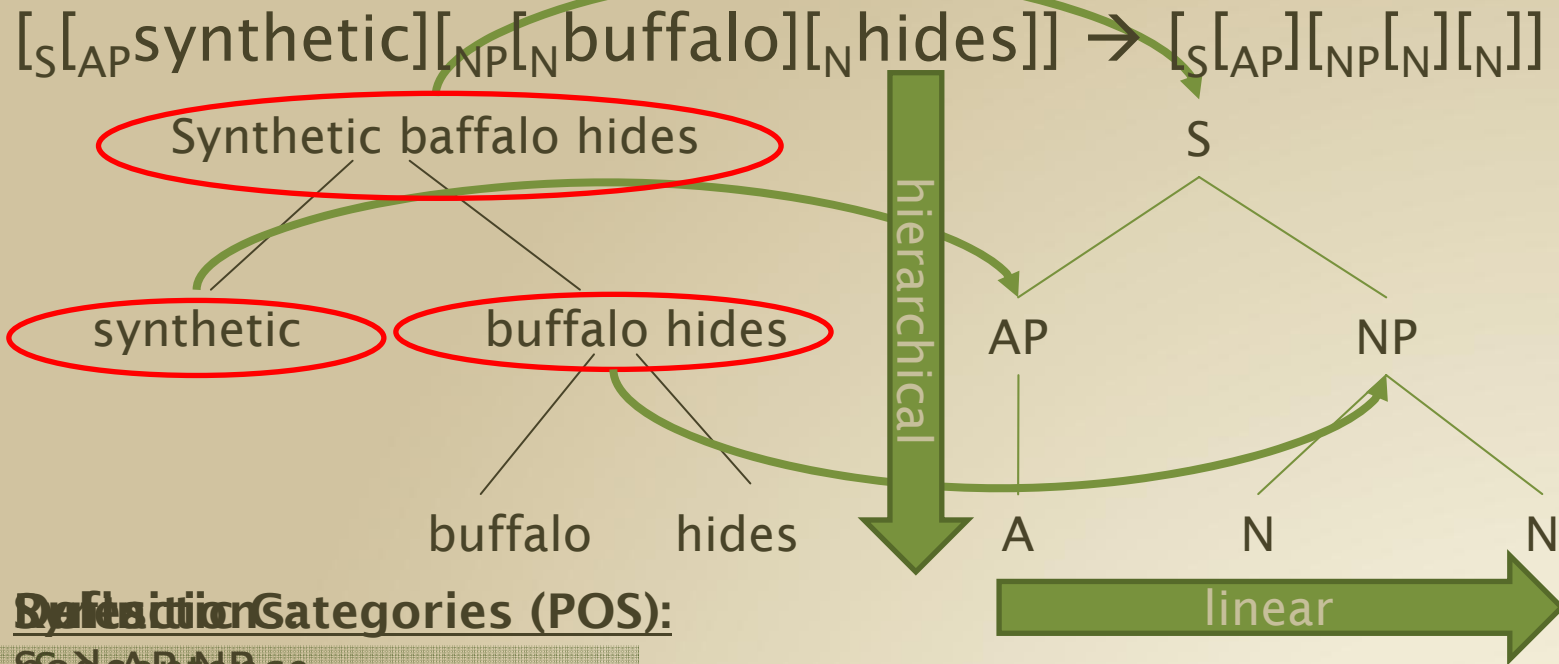
